A one-movement quartet for piano, violin, viola and cello.

PIANO QUINTET | ALEPPO (2016)

DURATION: 22 minutes

A three-movement quintet for piano, violin I, violin II, viola and cello. Commissioned by the Apollo Chamber Players and World Premiere performance on October 16, 2016 at Midtown Arts and Theater in Houston.

SAXOPHONE QUARTET | HOME (2021)

DURATION: 17 minutes

A three-movement saxophone quartet commissioned by Wright State University and World Premiere performance on March 28, 2018 at Schuster Hall. Currently on tour with Amstel Quartet throughout Europe.

DURATION: 5 minutes

A song for two vocals, piano and cello.

DURATION: 46 minutes An eight-track album featuring works for piano, oud and cello.

THE HUNT FOR PEACE (2018)

DURATION: 21 minutes

A one-movement solo piano work composed in 2018 for the 32 Bright Clouds project and received its World Premiere by pianist Yael Weiss on January 24, 2019 in Washington, D.C. It is connected to Beethoven's Sonata no. 18 in E flat Major Op. 31 No. 3 "The Hunt". The piece is dedicated to the Syrian children and their noble quest for peace.
